Final Instruction 1 (11-02-2016)

1. Scrutiny and documentation.

Scrutiny: Iverk Show Grounds Piltown. Co. Kilkenny. N52°21.556` W7°19.731`

Scrutiny from 15:00 hrs. to 20:00 hrs.

The club will not be using slot times for this event.

Numbers must be collected and affixed before scrutiny.

Any additional lights fitted to a competing car must be presented during scrutiny (Fitted and Working).

The Rally Office is in the Piltown GAA Complex (beside Iverk Show Grounds) on Saturday evening for licences and collection of documentation. It will close at 20:30 hrs. Please come early.

2. Parc Ferme

Parc Ferme is located in the car park at the rear of the GAA Complex.

All cars must go to Parc Ferme directly after scrutiny.

Security will be provided in Parc Ferme.

3. TRAILER PARK

No Trailers or Service Veichles are allowed into the GAA Complex Saturday or Sunday.

Unloading of cars must take place on the hard core road surfaces in the IVERK SHOW GROUNDS. NO EXCEPTIONS.

EMPTY TRAILERS MAY BE PARKED ON THE ADJOINING GRASS SURFACE

Trailer Park is in the Iverk Show Grounds from 13:00 hrs and gates will be locked at 21:00 hrs. Saturday. It will reopen at 07:00 hrs. Sunday.

Trailers parked at owners risk.

4. SERVICE PARK.

MILL RIVER BUSINESS PARK, Carrick-on-Suir N52°21.042` W7°25.024`

The Service Park will open At 0715Hrs on Sunday 14th Februauy.

One service vehicle per rally car. Spaces limited. First come, First served. The service area is operating a one way system, Left Hand Entry, please obey Marshals.

There is a short service (MILL RIVER BUSINESS PARK) between Parc Ferme and SERVICE 1 OUT CONTROL.

Ground Sheets Must be used In Service Area.

Please Tidy all rubbish as you go.

5. COMPETITON

All Competitors **must** be ready to start once they leave an S.A.C. Delays will not be accepted (if not ready when instructed to start the stage, the time it takes to get ready will be your penalty) **THE PENALTY IS SELF INFLICTED** your co-operation is appreciated.

Telephone number from either driver or navigator is required at documentation. This is to help with the safe running of the event and to assist with car accountability. Should you retire from the event please contact rally control on **086 /087-2670445 this is also printed on your time card.**

Mandatory red triangles and OK Board to be erected in the event of a car breaking down or for any other reason. **The onus is on competitors to clear any stage blockage.**
