B: Navigation Trial cars up to 1400 c.c.

C: Navigation Trial cars from 1401 to 2000 c.c.

D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars. (Retro cars as defined in Appendix 33)

E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars. (Retro cars as defined in Appendix 33)

The Overall winner will be decided from Class A1 & A2 only.

3. Awards

General Classification: 1st; 2nd; 3rd Overall.

Class Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each class - 2 Trophies.
