Recce Sign -On

- Rally office will be in the Ballybrit Suite, Clayton Hotel, Ballybrit, Galway on Saturday 9th February between the hours of 08.30am and 12pm.

Recce

- Pace note making takes place on Saturday 9th February between 9am and 5pm. Please respect the residents on the stages and obey the 40kph speed limit. Last admission into any stage is 4.30pm. A maximum of three passes only per stage.

Licence / IRDS

- Both driver and co-driver must produce current competition licences at recce sign on.
- Please ensure that driver has current IRDS / BRDS in time for Documentation Scrutiny and that it is listed on the Motorsport Ireland database.

Mechanical Scrutiny / Trailer Park & Parc Ferme

- Mechanical Scrutiny & Trailer Park will take place in Westlink Business Park, Oranmore, from 1.30pm until 5.00pm on Saturday 9th February 2019. Scrutiny slots will be posted on www.galwayrally.com
- Parc Feirme is located in the Car Park behind Caulfield's Oranmore Business Park

It is important that all cars use the following procedure when unloading competition cars for scrutiny:

- 1.** You must proceed directly to the unloading area as directed by a marshal.
- 2.** After unloading the rally car, you will be directed as to when to bring the car to mechanical scrutiny by a marshal.
- 3.** After Mechanical Scrutiny, the car must then be driven directly to Parc Ferme.
- 4.** Both crew members must attend documentation scrutiny in the Ballybrit Suite, Clayton Hotel within **30 minutes of completing mechanical scrutiny.**

Mechanical Scrutiny takes place from 13.30hrs – 17.00hrs.

Documentation Scrutiny will close at 19.30hrs sharp.

Drivers Briefing

- Drivers Briefing for International, National, Historic and Junior crews will take place in The Clayton Hotel, On Sunday morning 10th February at 07.00 sharp.

Re-seeding

- Re-seed forms will be available at Recce Sign On and must be posted in the re-seed box in Rally Office at the Ballybrit Suite, Clayton Hotel, **before 18.00hrs on Saturday 9th February.**

Service Area etc.

- Service area is located in the Athenry Livestock Mart on Sunday 10th February
- Service area will open at 06.30am
- All vehicles must be parked by 08:00am
- Please respect the residents in the vicinity of service.
- All competition cars must use a large non porous service mat.
- Penalty for not using a mat or littering the service area is two minutes
- Strictly **NO PARKING** on the main road outside service.
- Please dispose of all rubbish in service using the bin bags provided in your pack and place in the skip in the service area.
- There is a one way system in operation in service at all times.
- **NEW REQUIREMENT:** The Service Area is a **NO SMOKING AREA** for the duration of the event. Motorsport Ireland has issued new requirements in relation to rally service areas. Please see attached letter and attachments.

Class 24:

- R5 Derivatives converted from left hand drive to right hand drive for use on the national section of international events, run under a Motorsport Ireland National Permit. All other components must comply with the car's homologation.
See Appendix 29.1 Article 24.
- **Cars competing in Class 24 are not eligible for overall awards in the National section of an International Rally**
