- 1. The Event is an open Endurance Trial, promoted and organized by Wexford Motor Club Limited, hereinafter called the promoters. It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (MI), Appendix 35 MI Yearbook 2019, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event.
- 2. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and will close on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2019

The entry fee is as follows: €230

**Total Entry amount Due:** €230 (Less a deduction of €7 per person for those aged 16 / 17)

Entry Forms must be fully completed and accompanied by a cheque (not post-dated) for €230 made payable to Wexford Motor Club Ltd. All Cheques will be lodged on receipt.

#### 3. The maximum entry for the event is 70.

Should any of the above be not reached, the organizers have the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. **Turbo and four-wheel drive vehicles are ineligible.** 

**4.** Cars will start at 1 (one) minute intervals, except where directed otherwise by the organisers (some selectives will be at 30 second intervals)

#### 5. Classes

The event will have seven classes as follows:

Class A1: Cars built to Endurance Specification up to 1000cc

Class A2: Cars built to Endurance Specification between 1001 and 1400cc

Class B: Navigation Trial cars up to 1400 cc

Class C: Navigation Trial cars from 1401 to 2000 cc

Class D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars

Class E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars

Class F: All Sports Cars \*

\* All MX5 roofs must be of a steel form, either bolted or stitch welded to the bodywork.

#### **Tyres for Endurance Events:**

- 1. The Starmaxx Ice Gripper tyre W810 and the Sunny Winter Grip SN3860 are the navigation sub committee approved control tyres for the driven wheels in the Endurance Classes A1 and A2 only.
- 2. Tyres are free in all other classes, as long as they comply with Appendix 35 21.14, (which prohibit the use of any tyre with an 'Open' tread which might lead to damage to the private lanes used) or tyres marked 'For competition use' or anything similar. The Scrutineers decision on this will be final. (An exception to this rule would be to allow the Yokohama A021R tyre in the historic classes only, even if marked 'For competition use', due to the unavailability of a suitable tyre for cars in these classes)

#### 6. Awards

• General Classification: 1<sup>st</sup>; 2<sup>nd</sup>; 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall (Combined from A1 and A2)

• Class Awards: 1<sup>st</sup>; 2<sup>nd</sup>; 3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class

Class A1: No Sub Division

Class A2: Will be divided into \* Master / Expert / Semi Expert / Novice / Beginner

Class B & C: No Sub Division
Class D, E & F
No Sub Division

#### The Overall Winner will be decided from Class A1 and A2 (Endurance Class) Competitors Only

Counting round of the Coffee Perfection 2019 Irish Endurance Championship.

Amalgamation of Classes or Additional awards may be announced at signing-on before the Event.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS:**

Those receiving awards for overall placing will not be eligible for class awards.

The Organisers reserve the right to re-classify a competitor considered ineligible for a class, and /or amalgamate as required.

Classification will be based on the performance of the Driver and not the Navigator.

Master	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first three overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 Months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial, promoted under an MSA or MI Permit
Expert	The class qualification is: Finishing in the first six overall in an Endurance Trail or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trail, promoted under a MSA or MI Permit
Semi Expert	The class qualification is: Finishing in the first fifteen overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, promoted under a MSA or MI Permit
Novice	The class qualification is: No class wins in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or any event promoted under MSA or MI Permit
Beginner	First year of Endurance Trials or Targa Rallies

#### 7. General Route.

Organisers will use 1:50,000 maps when they are setting out the route card, but it is not envisaged that competitors will need maps, as a route book will be provided.

Penalties as per Appendix 35 of the current 2019 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.
