Entries are open to all drivers who have held a competition license or who hold a full driver's licence (minimum 2 years) and log book which must be produced at scrutiny.

Entries are open on publication of these regulations

Competitors will be excluded from the results for the following offences: -

1. Unofficial Practice in any type of vehicle
2. Failure to wear safety belt and crash helmet of the approved type while on the course
3. Failure to have appropriate type fire extinguisher in the car at all times during the event
4. Failure to pass scrutiny or to arrive at scrutiny after practice has begun
5. Failure to obey a reasonable request from an official

Scrutiny Requirements

- 1) All competing vehicles must carry a Seat Belt Cutter
- 2) All cars must pass scrutiny
- 3) All cars must be fitted with fire extinguishers of approved type
- 4) All cars must be fitted with full roll cage and have laminated windscreens
- 5) All cars must be fitted with FIA approved seats
- 6) Fire proof clothing must be worn
- 7) Overhead/roof skid pans and side netting are compulsory on specials
- 8) Forestry/gravel tyres may not exceed 5mm grip
- 9) Sump guards are recommended

Classes

Class 1: All Saloon cars up to 1450cc

Class 2: All Saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 3: All Saloon cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder

Class 4: All Saloon cars from 1651cc to 2100cc

Class 5: All Saloon cars over 2100cc, 4WD cars and Turbocharged Saloon cars

Class 6: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies over 601cc. Only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 7: Car Engined Specials, only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 8: Intermediate Class for 16 to 18 year olds, in saloon cars up to 1650cc, **under 18 year olds must have a parent/guardian permission**

Class 9: Junior Class for 14 to 16 year olds, holding a Junior license in saloon cars up to 1450cc, **under 18 year olds must have parent/guardian permission**

Class 10: Motorcycle Engined Specials including Buggies up to 600cc, only open to competitors 18 years and over

Class 11: Super Special Saloon's

Awards

Specials/Buggies and Saloon, 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class, winners of the overall award will not be eligible for class awards. Additional awards may be presented.

THE CLERK OF THE COURSE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY without having to assign a reason. Entry forms and the entry fee of €100 are to be paid on the day
