1. The Event is an open Endurance Trial, promoted and organised by County Galway Motor Club Limited, hereinafter called the promoters. It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland (MI), Appendix 35 MI Yearbook 2022, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event.

2. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and will close on Monday 12 September 2022

The Standard Entry fee is as follows: €275

(Less a deduction of €7 per person for those aged 16 / 17)

All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form, available on www.shannonsportsit.ie/evo/ and must be completed and signed by the entrant, driver and navigator. The entry fee must be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer or cheque forwarded to the Entries Secretary. Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned.

All drivers and navigators must hold a valid competition licence of an appropriate grade and all drivers must be listed on the IRDS/BRDS database which is published weekly on the Motorsport Ireland website.

3.The maximum entry for the event is 70.

Should any of the above be not reached, the organizers have the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. **Turbo and four-wheel drive vehicles are ineligible.No LED lights allowed**

4. Cars will start at 1 (one) minute intervals, except where directed otherwise by the organisers (some selective will be at 30 second intervals)

5.Classes

The event will have seven classes as follows:

A1: Cars built to Endurance specification up to 1000cc.

A2: Cars built to Endurance specification from 1001 to 1400cc.

B: Navigation Trial cars up to 1400cc (Navigation Trial cars as defined in Appendix 33, including such cars if fitted with cages and Sports cars fitted with cages, but excluding 4WD).

C: Navigation Trialcars from 1401 to 2000cc(Navigation Trial cars as defined in Appendix 33, including such cars if fitted with cages and Sports cars fitted with cages but excluding 4WD).

D: Front Wheel Drive Retro type cars (retro cars as defined in Appendix 33).

E: Rear Wheel Drive Retro type cars (retro cars as defined in Appendix 33).

F: All Other Sports Cars.

Tyres for Endurance Events:

Class A1 & A2: Control Tyres ONLY. Mandatory on ALL wheels (including spare wheels)

1. The Starmaxx Ice Gripper Tyre W810 :Petlasand the Sunny Winter Grip SN 3860 are the Navigation Sub Committee Approved Control Tyresin the Endurance Classes, A1 and A2 only.Click [HERE](#) to view tyre list.
2. Tyres are free in all the other classes, as long as they comply with Appendix 35 21.14,(an exception to this rule would be to allow the Yokohama A021R tyre in the Historic Classes only, even if marked 'For competition use', due to the unavailability of a suitable tyre for cars in these classes).

6.Awards

General Classification: 1st;2nd;3rdOverall (Combined from A1 & A2)- 2 Awards.

Class Awards:

- Class A1 - No sub divisions
- Class A2 - Will be divided into * Master / Expert / Semi Expert / Novice /Beginner
- Class B & C - No sub divisions
- Class D /E /F - No sub divisions.

The Overall winner will be decided from Class A1and A2(Endurance Class) competitors only.

Amalgamation of Classes or Additional awards may be announced at signing-on before the Event.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS:

Those receiving awards for overall placing will not be eligible for class awards.

The organisers reserve the right to re-classify a competitor considered ineligible for a class, and/or amalgamate as required. Classification will be based on the performance of the Driver and not the Navigator.

* Master	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first three overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial or Rally, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit.
Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first six overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or winning any event, except a Navigation Trial or Rally, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Semi Expert	This class qualification is: Finishing in the first fifteen overall in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Novice	This class qualification is: No class wins in an Endurance Trial or Targa Rally in the previous 12 months, or any event promoted under an MSUK or MI Permit
Beginner	First year of Endurance Trials or Targa Rallies

7. General Route

Organisers will use 1:50,000 maps when they are setting out the route card, but it is not envisaged that competitors will need maps, as a route book will be provided.

8. Start Order

Competitors will be seeded based on the information provided on the Entry Form and from information which may be found elsewhere, for example, rally and championship results.

9. Force Majeure or Baulking

The organisers will not accept any claim from competitors concerning either Force Majeure or Baulking.

PENALTIES

Penalties as per Appendix 35 of the 2022 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

SCRUTINY REQUIREMENTS – ALL VEHICLES.

Scrutiny Requirements as per Appendix 2 and Appendix 35 of the 2022 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook

NB: Competitors in ALL CLASSES must wear helmets, (these helmets do not have to be in date but do need to be in good condition)

NB: All cars must have a current, valid NCT / MOT certificate, unless exempt.
